COMMUNITY FORUM MEETING WITH FLICK DRUMMOND MP

Dear Applicant,

We just received this email from Stuart Crow, PA to our MP, Flick Drummond. As you will see from the email trail, it is in response to letters that many of us have received "out-of-the-blue" from BT, offering us fibre broadband through a cost-sharing scheme with other households. This is plainly not the same as our original application to Openreach, which relied on the Government's Gigabit Broadband Voucher Scheme and which, in our case, would probably have fully funded the entire application. As we understand it, there is now an indefinite hold on that voucher scheme.

However, this email trail promises a meeting with the MP, on the 13th of May at 4pm at The Flower Pots Inn, Cheriton. It is hoped that there will be panellists from Building Digital UK (BDUK), Hampshire County Council Broadband group, BT, a mobile operator (thought to be EE) and others.
